We celebrate *Holy Communion* on the first Sunday in the month in the evening and third Sunday in the month in the morning.

We hold a *Service of Healing* in the evenings approximately every two months.

Several times each year the whole church family worships together for the entire service. This includes Parade and special Festival Services.

We have a **twinning link** with 4 villages in eastern Germany, with our most recent visit to them in August 2008.

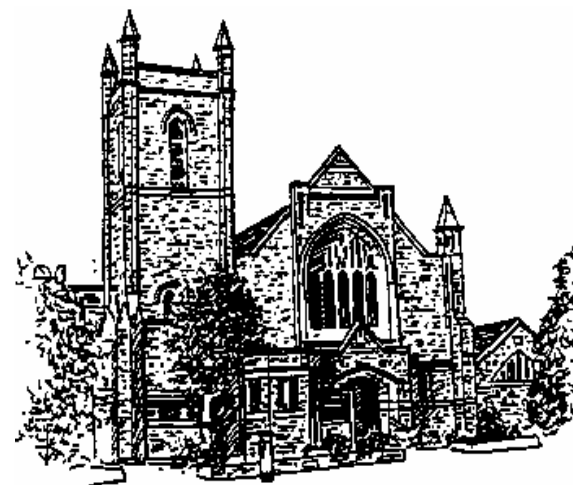
